# European Social Fund and BIG Lottery



Building Better Opportunities is a programme which will address social inclusion in the Tees Valley area by delivering activities which support those most disadvantaged to move towards the labour market. The first phase of the programme will be delivered between 2016 and 2019. £9.1 million will be available (£5.6m ESF and Big Lottery match of £3.6m) for this phase.

## The Programme Development Work so far...

The Big Lottery selected Hartlepool Voluntary Development Agency to carry out research and development work for the Tees Valley Building Better Opportunities programme. This work drew on data about the Tees Valley, considered reports and studies around social exclusion and consulted with stakeholders. It led to three themes for the Tees Valley Building Better Opportunities programme

### Theme One

#### Removing Health and Wellbeing **Barriers to Employment**

People with poor mental health or wellbeing.

People with substance misuse issues

People with lifestyle issues.

People living in the most deprived areas in the Tees Valley.

#### Theme Two

#### **Steps towards Employment**

Providing unemployed people with volunteering opportunities.

Providing unemployed people with

work experience opportunities.

Building the capacity of organisations to provide volunteering and work

experience opportunities.

## Theme Three

#### **Financial Inclusion**

Providing support to manage debt and increase financial literacy.

Providing transport to help people to

tackle isolation and gain

employment.

Providing people with digital inclusion services.

The three themes will be combined and delivered as a single service across the Tees Valley. This may involve a range organisations working as a partnership.
