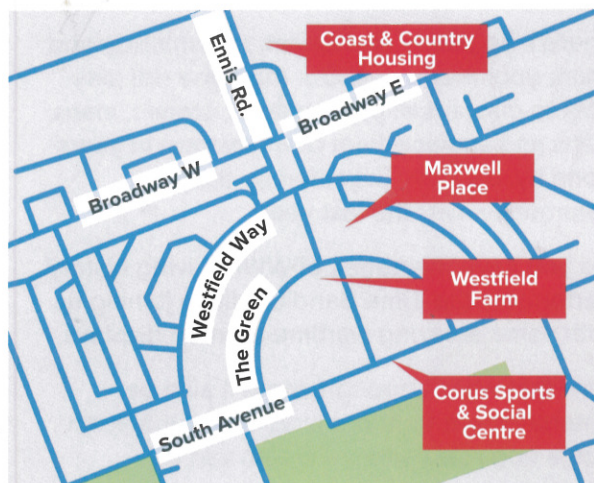
## HOW TO FIND US

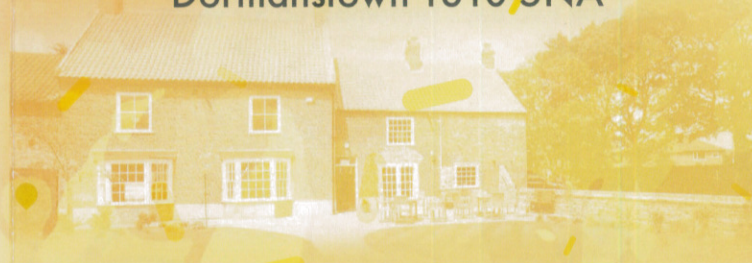

Do you have memories of WWII? Living history performers the Time Bandits will be joining us with some amazing wartime-themed displays.

The Royal Sapphires Jazz Band will kick off day two of our centenary celebrations with a parade from Westfield Farm up and down Maxwell Place, joined by members of The Old Dormanstown Delegates.

The fun goes on at Westfield Farm for a second day with more performances by the Time Bandits, magician, juggler, free face painting and another chance to view historical photographs and memories collected by members of the local community in our marquee.

We're delighted to be joined for the day by local busker, Norman Evans MBE who is well-known across the Redcar area for his charity fundraising.

Then it's time to get creative with a children's historical fancy dress competition! Which era from the last 100 years will you choose? The winner will be announced at 1pm.
